HURON COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS OVER \$28,000 IN COMMUNITY GRANTS TO SEVERAL HURON COUNTY NON-PROFITS AND SCHOOLS

Norwalk, Ohio, March 21, 2024 – At the March meeting of its Board of Directors, Huron County Community Foundation awarded \$28,017 in charitable community grants to several Huron County non-profits and schools. Projects awarded fill critical needs, create opportunities for youth, and further contribute to a thriving community.
