HURON COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS OVER \$28,000 IN COMMUNITY GRANTS TO SEVERAL HURON COUNTY NON-PROFITS AND MUNICIPALITIES

Norwalk, Ohio, April 3, 2025 – At the April meeting of its Board of Directors, Huron County Community Foundation awarded \$28,295 in charitable community grants to several Huron County non-profits and municipalities. Projects awarded fill critical needs, create opportunities for youth, and further contribute to a thriving community.

Huron County Community Foundation's Board of Directors identified priorities around the youth of the community, whether that be the food that nourishes them and their families or offering art and cultural experiences to expand their world view.
